<u>City Council positions on the ballot this November 5</u>. Voter Mobilization Steps (Plan must be duplicated for the December Runoff Election)

We are asking Bible-teaching pastors and churches in fulfilling the following critical action steps in through Election Day, November 5:

- Key Dates
 - <u>Early Voting</u> November 27; December 2-10
 - Election Day Saturday, December 14
- 1. Voter INFORMation: Current December 14
 - a. Distribute the HAPC Church Voter Guide with candidates' responses on issues for church distribution and church voter access.
 - b. Download and use video and audio clips (30 and 60 second) of key pastors promoting biblical voting and turnout for use via;
 - i. Radio, web-based, social networking

2. Voter ACTivation: Current – December 14

- a. Prepare and deliver "Get Out To Vote" sermons, messages, announcements, PowerPoints, texts, emails, etc.
- b. Post Early Voting and Election Day reminders and County Clerk Election site info in every facet of church communications.
- c. Lead Congregation to pray for the election, the hearts of the people and future of the city.
