



2020 Texas Primary Election Key Dates

1. **Friday, February 21** – Last day to apply for ballot by mail
 - a. Received by county election office, Not postmarked
2. **Monday, February 3** – Last day to register to vote for March 6 Primary
 - a. Voter registration card must either be received by county office or postmarked before this date.
3. **Tuesday, February 18** – First day of early voting
 - a. All voters can vote at ANY polling place within their county!
 - b. Very important to vote for EVERY position on the ballot!
4. **Friday, February 28** – Last day of early voting
5. **Tuesday, March 3** – **Primary Election**
 - a. Voters must vote in their own precinct
6. **Tuesday, March 3** – **Party Precinct Conventions**
 - a. Takes place immediately after polls close
 - b. Help shape the political party platforms by attending, becoming a delegate to the Senate District or County Convention!
 - c. The platform is where the core values of each political party are expressed and formally declared – YOU DECIDE!
7. **Tuesday, May 26** – **Primary Runoff Election**
