## HC & MC PRIMARY ELECTION VOTER GUIDE & FAQs

Harris County & Montgomery County, Texas • Primary Election: March 3, 2026

### Q. When is Primary Election Day in Texas?

A. Primary Election Day is **March 3, 2026**. Early voting runs from **February 17 through February 27, 2026**. Visit your county election office website (listed below) for specific polling hours and locations.

### Q. What about voter guides?

A. Not all voter guides are trustworthy, and it is rare to find one that you agree with entirely. Review voter guides prepared by various groups and compare them with your own research. Be cautious of deceptive voter guides. ### Q. How do I download my personal ballot?

A. Visit your County Election Administration office website to view your personal sample ballot:

**HC:** <https://www.harrisvotes.com/> (Click “Sample Ballot” and enter your personal information including party of choice)

**MC:** <https://elections.mctx.org/> (Click “Your Voter Registration Status” and enter your personal information including party of choice)

### Q. Where and when can I vote?

A. Visit your County Election Administration office website listed above to learn about dates, times, and polling locations during early voting and on Primary Election Day, March 3rd.

**Q. How do I pick the best candidate in each race?**

A. Pray and ask God for wisdom AND spend time researching each candidate. Visit the candidate resources and voter guides listed above to make an informed, prayerful decision at the ballot box.

**Q. What about the propositions on my ballot?**

A. There are 10 propositions advocated by the Republican Party of Texas to consider. Voters will indicate their agreement by selecting either **YES** or **NO** on the ballot. The results are non-binding but are important in legislative decision making and in priorities set by the Republican Party of Texas.
